**ECCLESIASTES 3:1-8 NKJV** – (1) To everything *there is* a season, a time for every purpose under heaven: (2) A time to be born, and a time to die; A time to plant, and a time to pluck *what is* planted; (3) A time to kill, and a time to heal; A time to break down, and a time to build up; (4) A time to weep, and a time to laugh; A time to mourn, and a time to dance; (5) A time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones; A time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing; (6) A time to gain, and a time to lose; A time to keep, and a time to throw away; (7) A time to tear, and a time to sew; A time to keep silence, and a time to speak; (8) A time to love, and a time to hate; A time of war, and a time of peace.
